T. 2002 Assessing the Risk of Corporate Default Venice, Italy 19-20 September 2002 GRETA Associati (Venice, Italy) and IntesaBCI (Milan, Italy) are co-sponsors of a Conference to be held in Venice on September 19-20, 2002. The objective of the Conference is to bring together academics, practitioners and PhD students working in the area of credit risk modelling.
