2004 EUROPEAN MEETING OF THE ECONOMETRIC SOCIETY ANNOUNCEMENT AND CALL FOR PAPERS The 2004 EUROPEAN MEETING of the Econometric Society will take place on the Campus of Universidad Carlos III, Madrid, Spain, from August 20 to 24. For the second time, the EEA Annual Congress and the Econometric Society European Meeting (EEA-ESEM) will run in parallel at the same place. Registering for either the Congress or the Meeting, participants will be eligible to attend all sessions of both conferences. Economists, including those who are currently not members of the Econometric Society, are invited to submit papers in Theory and Applied Economics and in Econometrics and Empirical Economics for presentation at the Meeting. The Program Committee Chairs are Professor Benny Moldovanu, University of Bonn, for Theoretical and Applied Economics and Professor Jean-Marc Robin, University Paris I and CREST-INSEE, for Econometrics and Empirical Economics. Each author may submit only one paper to the ESEM. The same paper cannot be submitted to both the ESEM and the EEA Congress. Submissions can be made from December 1, 2003 the deadline is February 15, 2004. Papers can only be submitted electronically through the EEA-ESEM 2004 website at www.eea-esem2004.org. They must consist of a single PDF file with a maximum size of 2MB. No other format will be accepted. Information links on the creation of PDF files will be available on the web site. Authors will be notified regarding acceptance or rejection by April 15, 2004. Authors presenting papers must have registered by June 1, 2004. The only means of registering is through the EEA-ESEM 2004 web site at www.eea-esem2004.org. The web site will open for registration on December 1, 2003. The last day for early registration (at a reduced fee) is June 1, 2004.
