E E F S European Economics and Finance Society Call for papers The Third Annual EEFS Conference, will be held at the University of Gdansk, Poland on 13-16 May 2004. The topic of the Conference will be on: "World Economy and European Integration" The Conference will focus on the changes we observe in the global economy and on the European Integration process. Papers are solicited in such areas as: European integration analysis of financial markets, economic geography, international monetary economics, international trade and general equilibrium, macroeconomics, growth and development, industrial economics and organisation, labour economics, new political economy, public economics, topics on the dotcom/digital economy. It is envisaged that a number of papers from this Conference will be published in special issues of established journals in the forthcoming months. Paper Submission Abstracts, papers and/or session proposals should be submitted to Professor Wlodzimierz Siwinski, Professor Anna Zielinska-Glebocka, Professor Miroslaw Szreder and Professor George Agiomirgianakis as attached files (doc or pdf format) to the following address eefs@gnu.univ.gda.pl An entire paper may be submitted, when available, but it must include an abstract. Abstracts should not exceed 200 words, and should contain JEL classification codes. The authors should indicate their full name, affiliation, address, phone/fax, and e-mail for correspondence. Proposals for complete sessions are encouraged. Each session should be made up of three papers. In the submitted proposals, session organizers should indicate the name of the session chair, the names, affiliations, contact numbers and e-mail addresses of the authors and the chair, the titles of the papers each accompanied by the paper abstract. Participants are expected to serve as program chair at Conference sessions. The submission deadline is March 31st. Authors are expected to send an electronic copy of the paper by May 3rd in order to facilitate its reproduction for the relevant session. After that date it is the responsibility of the authors to bring enough copies to the session. The conference web address is at http://gnu.univ.gda.pl/~eefs/ where you can find information regarding the Conference Programme, recommended accommodation and maps/instructions, and how to get there. This address will be available from December 1st. The Conference fee will be Euro 150 this includes some lunches and dinners. Concessions: Ph.D. students whose papers are accepted for the conference do not have to pay the conference fee. Proof of student status is required.
