Over the past 15 years there has been a rapidly growing interest in herding behavior modeled as an outcome of rational learning from others. This workshop will provide a venue for the exchange of ideas among researchers in this field. Some suggested areas of the field that can be covered in this workshop: - Variations on the basic theoretical models: exogenous/endogenous timing, free/costly signals, full/limited history observation, payoff function variations, etc. - Herd control: Manipulations of the herd by a social planner or other interested parties - Bounded rationality and herding - Herding in the lab: Experimental results - Applications: Consumers, investors, forecasters, financial markets, etc. The initial plan is to have about 20 presentations in sequence. Each speaker will get around 30-40 minutes for the presentation. Funding: The research grant for Dynamic Economic Theory from the Danish Social Science Research Council provides financial support. We can cover (reasonable) travel costs and local costs (hotel, food) for the speakers. There will be free access to attend the talks for non-speakers, but please register in advance by email to peter.norman.sorensen@econ.ku.dk.
