ANNOUNCEMENT and CALL FOR PAPERS CONFERENCE TITLE: Small Open Economies in a Globalized World CONFERENCE DATES: August 29th 2006 - September 2nd, 2006 We would like to invite you to submit a paper for presentation at the conference "Small Open Economies in a Globalized World" (SOEGW). The conference will be held at the Rimini campus of the University of Bologna on August 29th -September 2nd, 2006. The SOEGW conference is an international meeting aimed at assembling an international group of leading economists to present and discuss their research on issues concerning small open economies in the fast changing environment of the current globalized world. The conference will focus on international trade in goods and services, including tourism, international finance and international monetary and fiscal policies. Since small open economies are facing challenges in dimensions which bypass the usual borders of international economics, we also invite papers in other areas of economics, including business cycles analysis, economic geography, general equilibrium, growth, industrial organization, labour economics, quantitative methods and regional development. During the conference proceedings, Professor Robert Mundell will be awarded an Honorary Degree by the University of Bologna. The conference is organized by Canadian and Italian economists but is open to scientific contributions from all over the world. Authors should submit an extended abstract of up to 500 words. Please include with the submission JEL classification codes for the paper, keywords as well as JEL classification codes of the author(s) specialization field(s). Complete papers may be submitted but the extended abstract is required. In case of more than one author, please note the corresponding author. The submissions should be sent in PDF format to the address provided below. The deadline for submissions is 31/03/2006. The authors will be notified no later than 30/04/2006 whether their papers have been accepted. Proposals for sessions, consisting of three papers, are particularly welcome. If you are interested in submitting a session please send the session topic, paper titles and names of authors and arrange for the abstracts to be sent to the address provided below by 31/03/2006. Session organizers will be notified no later than 30/04/2006 whether their sessions have been accepted.
