We are inviting submissions of high-quality research papers for the special issue of the Euro-Mediterranean Economics and Finance Review (EMEFIR) dealing with Financial Markets, Crisis and Governance. Financial markets around the world are still experiencing signs of crisis. The recent economic and financial events (e.g., U.S. subprime market failures, debt crisis in the Euro zone, high instability in financial spheres, etc.) revive the scientific interest in investigating the nature and the conditions under which financial crisis have occurred as well as the ways in which we can avoid the plausible disastrous effects of the crisis. Some intriguing questions arise such as: Could we pretend that the actual debt crisis in the Euro zone will not affect other regions? What are possible solutions to prevent future economic and financial crisis? The scope of this special issue is thus to analyze the actual crisis and to shed light on the potential solutions and key issues to overcome the possible collapse of the financial system. All submissions must be in English and contain original unpublished work not being considered for publication elsewhere. Submissions will be refereed according to standard procedures.
